

1. Unite Here Local 11 is waging an aggressive corporate campaign against the Charging Party's employer, Terranea Resorts, to force the employer to assist the Union with organizing the Charging Party and ^{(b) (6), (7)(C)} co-workers.			
2. During its campaign, the Union has picketed or caused to be picketed Terranea, with an object of forcing or requiring the employer to recognize or bargain with the Union and of forcing or requiring Terranea employees to accept or select the Union as their representative, without an election petition being filed within a reasonable period of time or thirty-days from the commencement of that picketing. The Union continues to picket or threaten to picket Terranea in pursuit of these objectives.			
3. By and through this and related conduct, the Union is violating Sections 8(b)(7) of the Act. Charging Party requests relief for ^{(b) (6), (7)(C)} and all similarly situated employees, including relief under Sections 10(l) of the Act.
