Local 89 has either violated and/or refused to satisfy the terms of the NLRB Settlement signed 8/17/17. Conditionally closed on continued compliance 10/16/18, despite dissatisfaction email to Field Examiner Grosh dated 8/13/18.

The complainant asserts that more likely than NOT **(b) (6), (b) (7)(C)** perjured **(b) (6), (b) (7)(C)** before the NLRB. Submitting deliberately false and/or misleading testimony to bring about 10/16/18 settlement closing. It is requested, in addition to the NLRB pursuing the appropriate penalty if **(b) (6), (b) (7)(C)** is found to have committed PERJURY. NLRB Settlement dated 8/17/17 be reinstated until ALL terms are verified and deemed fully satisfied by the signatory parties

For three or four months the (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) tricked letter carriers into believing that (b) (6) was working on one ongoing Article 8 overtime grievance. When questioned by employees (b) (6) would say that (b) (6) was working on one big case. months (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) told employees that (b) (6) was processing an ongoing grievance on their behalf. This was not true and about two weeks ago the carriers found out that there was no grievance. The (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) knew and did nothing about this.</p>

Being both bypassed settlement payment and denied requested documentation violates the Duty of Fair Representation.

On or about (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) 2019 (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) agreed to serve as "named party" in a class action National grievance settlement information request. \$8.64 million was arbitrated nationally. (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) refusal to now share discovered information with similarly affected (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) Points to (2) possible ULP's on the part of the APWU.

- 1) "Selective bypass" in Local 89's disbursement of Philadelphia installations allocation of \$8.64million settlement.
- 2) "Hush" payment arrangement to (b) (6), (b) (7)(C) to keep quiet both date of \$8.64 and settlement amount in said selective bypass.
