Since on or about September 27, 2018, and continuing thereafter, the above referenced labor organization, by its officers, agents, and representatives, has failed and refused to bargain with the OK Grovery Company with respect to a mutually negotiated Driver Safety Management Policy. Specifically, after the parties negotiated over a period of 10 months, during which the parties met approximately 20 times and the Company made numerous concessions and adjustments to the proposed policy, the parties reached an agreement on the Driver Safety Management Policy. However, the Union has now repudiated that agreement, denying that they agreed to the Policy and falsely claiming that the Company unilaterally implimented the policy without bargaining with the Union.


